About the Artists

Kevin Winter is 3rd horn of the Louisiana Philharmonic Orchestra after spending his first two years as 4th horn. He is currently on faculty at Loyola and Tulane Universities and maintains a private teaching studio.

He completed his bachelor's degree at Baylor University, studying with Jeff Powers. He also holds a master's degree from the Cleveland Institute of Music, where he studied with Rick Solis. His other influences include Greg Hustis, David Cooper, and Haley Hoops.

He has spent previous summers with the Des Moines Metro Opera, National Repertory Orchestra, National Orchestral Institute, and Opera in the Ozarks. In his free time Kevin is an ardent fan of the Texas Rangers and tacos. He also enjoys bouldering and brewing his own beer, and he is his mother's favorite horn player.

Jamie Leff joined the Louisiana Philharmonic Orchestra as 2nd horn at the beginning of the 2018 season. Prior to joining the LPO, Jamie was the 2nd horn of the Houston Ballet Orchestra and was an active freelancer and teacher in the area. She has also performed with the Houston Symphony, Houston Grand Opera, the San Antonio Symphony, and the North Carolina Symphony.

Jamie received her Bachelor's degree from Indiana University's Jacobs School of Music, where she studied with Dale Clevenger, principal horn of the Chicago Symphony and Jeff Nelsen, hornist of the Canadian Brass. While there, Jamie had the opportunity to study abroad in Vienna, Austria, where she worked with Wolfgang Vladar, 3rd horn of the Vienna Philharmonic. She received her Master's degree from DePaul University, under the tutelage of Jim Smelser and Oto Carrillo of the Chicago Symphony. She also studied with Robert Johnson, the Associate Principal Horn of the Houston Symphony, before winning her first job with the Houston ballet.
